- The SEAA scholarship application process requires that the application be completed by the student. The applicant (student) must log-in to CFNC using his or her CFNC username and password. Do not use your parents' CFNC account. Applications that are not completed on a student's CFNC account will not be considered.
- Each applicant will be asked several preliminary questions that will help the applicant identify programs for which the applicant may be eligible to apply.
- All applications require the student applicant to have a valid, working email address. Email communication is the preferred method of communication used by SEAA's application process.
- Each application will begin with a fact sheet listing requirements for the program and required information for the application.
 - You may be required to list names and email addresses of individuals designated as your reference(s).
 - You may be required to list the name and email address of your school counselor (high school).
 - You may be required to write an essay.
 - You may be required to list activities and/or related courses taken.
- Some applications may allow you to save the application and return to it while others will require you to complete the application on your first attempt.

Recognizing that the North Carolina National Guard is the only organized, trained and equipped military force subject to the control of the State, the General Assembly established a program of tuition assistance for qualifying guard members for the purpose of encouraging voluntary membership in the guard, improving the educational level of its members, and thereby benefiting the State as a whole. The National Guard North Carolina Tuition Assistance Program is administered by the North Carolina State Education Assistance Authority (the Authority).

Who may apply?

To be considered for this benefit, a service member must:

- Be an active drilling member of the North Carolina National Guard prior to the start date of classes.
- Be an active drilling member and meet the service obligation of 2 years remaining in the North Carolina National Guard at the end of the academic period for which this award will be applied.
- Be attending an approved certificate or degree program at an institution of higher education approved by the Authority
- Meet the Satisfactory Academic Progress requirements for the approved institution of higher education
