

## BIVOUAC SITE



Units will not have any open flame heaters or fires inside or outside of their tents. As there is much wild life in and around Camp Butner, units must keep trash policed in heavy duty garbage bags at all times. No digging is allowed in any training area without permission from Range Control. Avoid wetlands, ponds, streams at all costs. If units have a highly congested area and are near a road way, units will supply an access guard to their site for Safety reasons. Road guides will be used when maneuvering in congested areas where troops are present. Unit OICs must remain cognizant of weather conditions and ensure they constantly update their risk assessment when extreme temperatures are prevalent. There are no power hook ups at these sites. The BIVOUAC Site must be requested using Range Facility Management Support System (*RFMSS*) no later than 90 days in advance.
