

## RANGE 9 – PRACTICE HAND GRENADE RANGE



LOCATION	Accessible through Keeton Trail. Located directly behind EST Buildings.
DESCRIPTION	Range 9 is a distance and accuracy practice hand grenade course that is designed to develop proficiency in gripping, preparing and throwing hand grenades. The course has multiple and single fixed targets positioned along six (6) offensive positions. Each lane ranges from 10 to 30 meters wide, and range from 10 to 75 meters long, and has 7 firing points.
