

## RANGE 1 – COMPETITIVE PISTOL RANGE



LOCATION	East Umstead Trail
DESCRIPTION	Range 1 consists of fifty (50) firing points with electronic facing and edging fixed targets located at 25MM 50MM. The system supports electronic timing facing and edging where the targets can be faced or edged from the control room located at the center of the range firing line. Cardboard target backs (24 inches square) are stored in a shed located east of firing point 50.
TYPE AMMUNITION AUTHORIZED	.22 - .45 Caliber
TYPE WEAPON SYSTEMS	Handgun
FIRING LINE	The firing line is covered with open sides ensuring that the shooter is not overly exposed to adverse weather conditions.
LEFT LIMIT	Identified with black and white stripped marker.
RIGHT LIMIT	Identified with black and white stripped marker.
LATRINE FACILITIES	Yes
CONTROL ROOM	Yes
COMPUTER SCORED	No
PA SYSTEM	Yes
CLASSROOM	No. However, there is a multipurpose building available (Bldg 3650).
AMMO SUPPLY POINT	No
RANGE CONTROL COMMUNICATION REQUIREMENTS	Establish communication with Range Control when occupied and maintain communications on the hour.
LOCATION OF RANGE FLAG POLE	East Umstead Trail at the entrance of Range 1 and Range 2.
LOCATION OF RANGE ROAD GUARDS	N/A
RESTRICTIONS	Range 1 is <b><u>not authorized</u></b> for reflexive fire, transition fire or shotgun training.
REMARKS	Range 1 is designed for bull's eye pistol competition and practice. It is also used for pistol training, marksmanship training, and standard police qualification. Range 1 is approved for use of steel targets, per CBTC steel policy. All steel targets, emplacements and training concepts must be approved by Range Control.
